About the Conference

Yet, for decades a globally gendered political culture has been dominating the discourse and critically looking at Bhartiya women through western-dominated academic perspective. A stereotype and critical image of Bhartiya woman as 'backward' has been historically shaped in the academic corridors of western scholarship. Though this image is gradually changing with the increasing participation of women in the narrative of growth, progress and development, their actual participation in the processes of creation of ideas and decision making is still questioned and looked at with a sense of skepticism.

It is in this context that the proposed two-day International Conference is aimed at revisiting, exploring and further consolidating the true strength of Bhartiya woman and her unique contribution towards society. In an attempt to locate women at the centre of national transformation, the conference aims at further articulating the women's contribution towards the mainstream narrative of nation building, growth and development.
